Old Business:

- 1. Adopt-a-Beach with Newspring Church-** Jenn Cribb planned to organize and complete a beach sweep with Newspring Church.
- 2. Purple Queen planting-** Before the first frost, the Purple Queen plants will be ready to harvest to replace at the pier and any other town sites deemed necessary. Request is to add 5 plants on the Pier beds on the left and right. Additionally, at the Welcome sign to the South end of the Town on 17 Business.

New Business:

- 1. Adopt-a-Beach with Newspring Church-** Jenn Cribb organized a beach sweep with Newspring Church. Jen was able to get parking for 8-12 free on Surfside Drive for the event. Meg Perrino was to get two limo golf carts from King of Carts and two limo carts from Graham Golf Carts for the event. Debra Herrmann would generate official letters for the golf cart dealers to retain on file. Drivers for the event would be Meg Perrino, Tabitha Mull, Al Lauer and citizen Jim Blanchard, and Jeff Hines. Cate Causey was to provide table, tent, carpet and sign for registration on the beach. MaryLynn Stalnaker and John Adair to be on premise to facilitate handing out of gloves, trash bags, and 25 trash pickers. Diana Taylor would go with teams from the church to go into the community to help 6 elderly citizens with yard work and localized cleaning.
- 2. Yard of the Month (YOM)-** Yard of the month nomination for September posted on Surfsideians Facebook, printed, framed and hung in the Town Hall and yard sign relocated to 710 Hollywood Drive N, Rosie Hastings-Weaver

3. Visitor Letter- Debra Herrmann received a Thank you letter from several women who visited our town over the summer. They highly noted the cleanliness of our beaches, the hanging flower baskets, the updates to the pier and our beautiful mural on the side of the business Borgata. 4. Cedar Drive Traffic Study- Meg Perrino reviewed the results of phase one from the traffic study conducted by town police. The results showed that only 1.5% of the traffic is speeding heading North from 10th Ave N. Currently phase two is still placed on the power pole at 11th Dr N. to study the traffic levels coming from 15th Ave N southbound towards the Cedar Dr. causeway. When those results are completed and reviewed Meg Perrino will review with the committee

5. Fall Beach Sweep, September 17- Meg Perrino to contact the Moms Club of Surfside and Myrtle Beach to gauge interest in attending. Meg Perrino to contact the Boy Scouts to see if they are interested as well. Tabitha made a motion to do beach sweeps quarterly as opposed to 2 times a year. Began discussions on what would be required of our committee to benefit this event. Event will occur before the next committee meeting August, 21.

6. Fall Festival, October 1- Discussed sharing a table with the Storm Water Committee at the Fall Festival. Discussed having a handout and showing people how to download the application on their phone to record trash pickup to help the town. Need to further discuss at next meeting.
