Chapter 9 Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Article I, In General, Section 9-16 Decals and exemptions, paragraph (4) *Beach access parking*.

9-16(4) *Beach access parking*. All golf carts, registered, unregistered, and commercial, may park free of charge at beach accesses **where there are no asphalt or paved parking lots** when space is available, except when prohibited by a sign.
