

Ralph Magliette Senior Citizens Committee
Meeting Minutes
December 14, 2015

1. The Committee welcomed Councilman Randle Stevens as our new Council liaison
 2. Councilman Stevens shared he will be continuing the Meet and Greet on the 1st Wednesday of each month at the Golden Egg Restaurant.
 3. Shelby gave us a preliminary review of the survey results. The 60 to 69 age group results showed the most wanted activities are beach, walking and golf. Walking, the beach and gardening were the most requested activities for the 70 to 79 age group.
 4. Wanda volunteered her husband Bob to create a spreadsheet for all results for all age groups. Results will be reviewed at the February meeting
 5. There was discussion about sponsoring a Senior Walk, possibly in the spring. Councilman Stevens said he would arrange for a Committee member to address the next business community meeting to encourage members to assist in sponsoring the walk. With adequate financial resources the participants would receive event t-shirts, medals or certificates of completion, snacks, water/juice and giveaways.
 6. Members declined to elect a new chairman for 2016. Wanda will remain as Chair of the committee
 7. No one volunteered to keep minutes. For now, Wanda will be responsible for taking notes, preparing the minutes and submitting to Town Hall in a timely manner.

9. Councilman Stevens offered to contact Clemson University to request a representative schedule a presentation on gardening.
 10. Parking at the Senior Center was discussed. The lot adjacent to the Center was recently purchased and the new owner will not allow the seniors to park on his lot. Currently they have to park on the grass across 10th Ave N and cross the street. Shelby and Councilman Stevens agreed to meet the next morning to look at the site and determine whether it could be paved as a parking lot. Purchasing the adjacent lot was also discussed. The owner is asking \$69,000.
 11. There will be a 2nd Annual Senior Fair, maybe an oyster roast and breakfast.
