### MIXED PAPER



**Newspapers, magazines, junkmail**  
(shred personal information)



**Phone books**  
(remove hard covers, recycle with cardboard)

### CARDBOARD



**Cereal, snack & cracker boxes**



**Corrugated cardboard boxes**  
(empty & flatten)

### BOTTLES & CANS

(remove & discard caps & lids, empty & rinse all containers)



**Aluminum and metal cans**  
(including aerosol)



**Plastic jugs and bottles (No. 1 - 7)**  
No Styrofoam



**Glass jars and bottles**

## Recycling NO



**Plastic bags**  
(recycle your bags at most grocery stores)



**Glass cookware & ceramics**



**Styrofoam, such as egg cartons, packaging or cups**



**Paper plates, napkins & plasticware**



**Lightbulbs**  
(recycle used CFLs at any Home Depot)



**Aluminum foil & trays**
