1. Our training this month centers on the beginning of hurricane season and what actions our members need to take to prepare. This training includes checking the cartons to ensure everything that would be needed to open the Emergency Operations Center is in place. During this training, we test the back-up radios and the cell phones.
2. I attended the 2018 Integrated Partner Workshop in Columbia. This workshop was hosted by the National Weather Service (NWS) and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA). This workshop had speakers from around the state that spoke about the issues that the weather has caused over the past few years. The speakers also spoke about the lessons learned.
3. We had two groups of children tour the station. One group was from Gateway Academy with 24 students and teachers. The second group was from St. James High School Special Needs Group and there were 16 students and instructors.
4. Captain Carter attended a defensive driving class hosted by the Municipal Association of South Carolina. This class was held at their offices in Columbia.
