WHEREAS, many residents of Surfside Beach may not fully comprehend the serious threat of hurricanes, having never experienced one; and


WHEREAS, being aware of the dangers associated with these storms and taking steps to mitigate their impact can minimize the risk of property damage, injury, and loss of life.
