WHEREAS, the Surfside Beach Town Council discussed this agreement at the September 12, 2017 regular meeting and concurred to bring it forward for consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Surfside Beach as a municipality within the Horry County boundaries receives assistance from time to time from the Horry County Police; and

WHEREAS, Horry County has hundreds of residents living in communities surrounding the Town of Surfside Beach the proximity to which there is no County facility nearby; and

WHEREAS, Horry County desires a mutual aid agreement so that the Surfside Beach Police Department may respond to emergency situations until the Horry County officers can arrive; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Surfside Beach desires to continue its good working relationship with the Horry County Police.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Surfside Beach Town Council hereby authorizes the Town Administrator to execute the Horry County/Horry County Police Department Mutual Aid Agreement on behalf of the Town of Surfside Beach and to comply with the terms thereof.
